**3. Speed Limit through village**

Council agreed that part of the main road through should be back to 40mph. Although not all, the bends and the beginning of the village should stay at 30mph it was agreed. However, from the old ice cream shop going into Ashby cum Fenby, this stretch, it was agreed would benefit from going back to the original 40mph. Ward Cllr Pettigrew was in support of this also. The member of public in attendance advised that he had seen detailed traffic report/survey previously undertaken for the road and would forward onto Cllrs.

**4. Flagpole**

Flagpole currently hidden by overgrown trees. Quote was sought to tidy up the area and cut back trees (£850) – possible Ward funding could be available for this work? Chair to forward quote to Clerk to submit for possible ward funding.
